The love of God is a paradox. It seems absurd to our human way of thinking, but once you take a closer look with God-blessed eyes, you discover the truth and mystery of His love. Each week, we study the paradoxes of the Bible and renew our minds to God's way of thinking, and then we live out that Truth in the practical details of our lives as we walk **the narrow pathway** together.
